When is a crown required?

Heavily filled, weak or cracked teeth. Large fillings fill the void but don't reinforce the healthy tooth structure. Cracks can spread from the corners which can lead to cusp breakage.

Severely decayed teeth. If your nerve is still alive, the priority is to protect it from further injury and exposure. If the nerve dies, you are likely to develop a serious toothache and abscess.

Root filled with little remaining tooth. After you get a root canal treatment it is vital to protect your tooth from breakage and reinfection.

Your dentist can prepare and place an OVC in just one appointment. You won't need to wait hours for your crown to be milled, or weeks for it to come back from the lab.
